I deleted this channel memory and then tried Upload To Radio again hoping I cleared the channel, with no luck. I know I was warned that this would happen so this is my fault. I went to the manufacture website to find specific software for my radio. It is a version C3 and they only have C2 software which did not work either. I have emailed them for C3 software.
