Description	<p>When downloading the data from the radio, location 1 always returns 0.0000 as the frequency and ERROR as the name.</p> <p>I am able to repeat this every time. The memory location, in my example, should be "146.82" with "CARS 2M" as the Name</p>

After doing a clear all reset on the VV-898, the apro setting on memory 1 is out of range (0xff), but the radio honors it as "off" anyway. This fix prevents such a memory from throwing an exception on download.
