Thank you for the information, that worked. One suggestion for your next release would be a "user setting selectable" for recent files. Zero for none and a drop down box for up to 5 would be great. I typically store none or 1, my current working copy that way. Otherwise it is to easy to accidentally open and modify the wrong file from the list. Great program, just starting to use it on my Baofeng UV-82HP. I have an older Yaesu FT-50r which has a programming cable. Is the Yaesu 50R on a list of radios that will work?
