<b>Description</b>			
<p>I have a UV-82HP, and I would like the top line to say the channel name, and on the bottom line I would like it to show the correct frequency of the channel I am on. Example: If I am on NOAA on the top line I would like it to show 162.525 on the bottom line. Which is the NOAA frequency in our area.</p> <p>I also have a UV-82C, UV-5R and a UV-5RTP I would like to do the same thing to (if possible).</p> <p>Is this possible? I have done so many google searches and read a bunch of articles. One man said he had his radio this way, but did not say how he did it.</p> <p>I have been playing around with the Settings in Chirp and I have the Name on the top line, but can't get the correct frequency on the bottom line.</p> <p>Thank you in advance, Dan Jolley</p>

The top (A) and bottom (B) display lines of these radios are independent. They have no means of automatically synchronizing them to the same channel. If you want a Baofeng like radio that has this capability, you would need a BTECH UV-5X3 sold by Baofeng Tech.

In the mean time you will just have to manually set both display lines to the same memory.
