Hi Mark,

CHIRP running on my Windows computer and my MacBook Air notebook computer can open both of these CHIRP Radio Images (\*.img) files. I suspect you are unaware that the MacOS Unified Application version of CHIRP is unable to access a few macOS folders (Desktop, Documents, Downloads, etc) and have your "image" file stored in one (or more) of them.

If these "image" files are stored in one of these folders (or a sub-folder located in any of them), then CHIRP won't be able to access these files. My workaround here was to create a CHIRP folder off of my user (Jim) folder to keep all of my CHIRP related files in.
